I have recently completed my first year of seminary, and I have been working at San Joaquin Catholic Cemetery here in Stockton as my summer assignment. I have the honor of working with a dedicated crew that maintains the grounds and facilitates the daily burials. My average workday may consist of weed-whacking for eight straight hours (with a lunch break) or assisting with as many as four burials in a single day, regardless of whether the temperature is a merciful 88 degrees with a cooling crosswind or a grueling 105 degrees under a scorching sun.

But the most important thing I do before every shift is prayer. I grab the starter cord of my weed whacker and I pray: “Lord God, I offer up today's toil, heat, stress, and sacrifices for the repose of the souls of all those who are buried here, and especially for those who have no one to pray for them. I place the sacrifice of this day before the throne of your mercy, Lord, on their behalf, for you are both the just judge and the merciful Father. Amen.” I then pull the starter cord on my weed whacker and get to work.

Paragraph 2300 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that burying the bodies of the dead must be done with respect and charity because we are all children of God and our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit. This is a Corporal Work of Mercy. Paragraph 958 then tells us that “it is a holy and a wholesome thought to pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins” and that we can offer up our sufferings for them. To pray for the living and the dead is a Spiritual Work of Mercy. By the grace of God, I have been given the unique opportunity this summer to perform both a Corporal and a Spiritual Work of Mercy for the dead at the same time throughout my workweek. But no matter where you, the reader, are, you always have the opportunity to perform the Spiritual Work of Mercy by praying and offering up sacrifices for all the souls in Purgatory.

I have seen one tombstone that showed a person had lived to be a hundred years old and another that heartbreakingly showed that the date of birth and date of death were the same day. I have seen a burial where over a hundred people dressed in black attended the gravesite service, and at the opposite extreme, I assisted in a burial where only two casually dressed mourners arrived to pay their respects and the casket was delivered in a minivan-not a hearse. But regardless of whether a person's life was long or short or whether one or one hundred people attended their funeral, they have gone before us into eternity and we have a solemn duty to respect their body, honor their memory, and pray for their soul. If they are in Purgatory, our prayers and sacrifices will speed their release so they can be with God forever in Heaven.

❧ RINCÓN DEL SEMINARISTA ❧

Recientemente he concluido mi primer año de seminario y este verano he estado trabajando en el Cementerio Católico San Joaquín, aquí en Stockton, como parte de mi asignación de verano. Tengo el honor de trabajar junto a un equipo dedicado que se encarga del mantenimiento de los jardines y de facilitar las sepulturas que se realizan cada día. Un día de trabajo típico puede consistir en pasar ocho horas seguidas despejando la maleza (con un descanso para el almuerzo) o en ayudar con hasta cuatro entierros en un solo día, sin importar si la temperatura es de unos benévolos 31 °C, acompañados por una refrescante brisa, o de unos agotadores 40 °C bajo un sol abrasador.

Pero lo más importante que hago antes de comenzar cada jornada es rezar. Tomo el cordón de mi podadora y rezó: «Señor Dios, te ofrezco el trabajo, el calor, el cansancio, el estrés y los sacrificios de este día por el descanso eterno de las almas de todos los que están sepultados aquí, y especialmente por aquellos que no tienen a nadie que rece por ellos. Pongo el sacrificio de esta jornada ante el trono de tu misericordia, Señor, en favor de ellos, porque tú eres a la vez el Juez justo y el Padre misericordioso. Amén».

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Después enciendo mi podadora y comienzo a trabajar.

El número 2300 del Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos enseña que dar sepultura a los cuerpos de los difuntos debe hacerse con respeto y caridad, porque todos somos hijos de Dios y nuestros cuerpos son templos del Espíritu Santo. Esta es una Obra de Misericordia corporal. Más adelante, el número 958 nos recuerda que «es un pensamiento santo y piadoso es orar por los difuntos para que sean liberados de sus pecados», y que también podemos ofrecer nuestros sufrimientos por ellos. Orar por los vivos y por los difuntos es una Obra de Misericordia espiritual. Por la gracia de Dios, este verano se me ha concedido la oportunidad singular de realizar, al mismo tiempo y a lo largo de mi semana de trabajo, tanto una Obra de Misericordia corporal como una Obra de Misericordia espiritual en favor de los difuntos. Sin embargo, sin importar dónde te encuentres tú, querido lector, siempre tienes la oportunidad de practicar esta Obra de Misericordia espiritual rezando y ofreciendo sacrificios por todas las almas del Purgatorio.

He visto una lápida que mostraba que una persona había vivido hasta los cien años de edad, y otra que, de manera desgarradora, mostraba la misma fecha como día de nacimiento y de fallecimiento. He presenciado un entierro al que asistieron más de cien personas vestidas de negro para acompañar el servicio junto a la tumba; y, en el extremo opuesto, ayudé en un entierro al que solo acudieron dos personas, vestidas de manera informal, para presentar sus respetos, mientras que el féretro llegó en una miniván y no en un coche fúnebre. Pero, independientemente de si la vida de una persona fue larga o corta, o de si a su funeral asistió una persona o un centenar, todos ellos nos han precedido en la eternidad. Tenemos el solemne deber de respetar su cuerpo, honrar su memoria y rezar por su alma. Si se encuentran en el Purgatorio, nuestras oraciones y sacrificios acelerarán su purificación para que puedan gozar para siempre de la presencia de Dios en el Cielo.

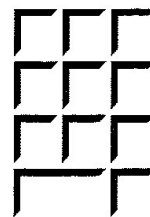
