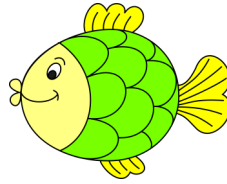


Annunciation School: "Saint Strong"

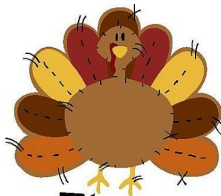

Cathedral of the Annunciation's Men's Ministry

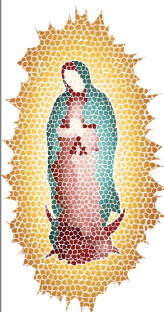
