MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR / MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

Last week, we discussed cultivating an attitude of gratitude—not just at the celebration of the Eucharist each Sunday for the salvation Jesus won for us with his death and resurrection but for all we have been given. Indeed, if we really stop to think about it, everything we have, everything we own, is a gift from God. We may think we have pulled ourselves up “by our own bootstraps” to be professionally successful, financially comfortable, or socially positioned, but just who gave us those gifts and opportunities to succeed, become comfortable, or positioned? God. If everything I have and own is a gift from the all-good God, then I also have an

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obligation to use these resources responsibly, since it is all God's.

Despite our experiences during the pandemic, we do not live in our own private worlds. We live with each other, who, just like us, have been created in God's image and likeness (Gn 1:27) and have incomparable human dignity. Our interrelatedness means we are accountable to one another. (Yes, we are our brother's keeper [Gn 4:9; see also Lk 10:29-37].) Thus, how we use or do not use what God has given us does affect others. We know this, for instance, with time. If we spend time on one thing, we have less time to spend on something else.

To see if we have been responsible with what God has entrusted us, we first have to know and appreciate what we have. Once we have a good handle on our talents, possessions, money, time, etc., then we can see if and how we are using them responsibly and accountably. Nurturing these virtues can develop in us hearts that break open and hold all of God's creation in wonder and gratitude.

A pesar de nuestras experiencias durante la pandemia, no vivimos en nuestro propio mundo privado. Nuestra correlatividad significa que somos responsables por los demás. (Sí, somos responsables y guardianes de nuestro hermano —GN 4:9, vean también Lk 10:29-37—.) O sea que, cómo usamos o no usamos lo que Dios nos ha dado, afecta a los demás. Esto lo sabemos, por ejemplo, con el tiempo. Si dedicamos tiempo en alguna cosa, tenemos menos tiempo para dedicarlo a otra cosa.

Para ver si hemos sido responsables con lo que Dios nos ha dado, tenemos primeramente que saber y apreciar lo que tenemos. Cuando tengamos una buena idea de nuestros talentos, posesiones, dinero, tiempo, etc. entonces podremos ver si estamos usándolos responsable y explicablemente. Nutriendo estas virtudes podemos revelar en nosotros corazones abiertos que guardan toda la creación de Dios en admiración y gratitud.

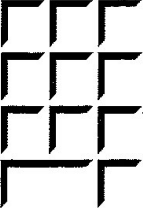
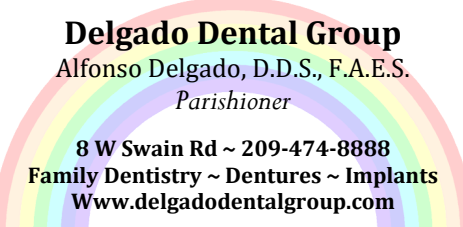
The research involves interviews with parents and separate interviews with their adult children.
