MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR / MENSAJE DEL PÁRROCO

Each year, the Gospel for the Third Sunday of Easter presents a post-resurrection appearance of Jesus to his disciples. This year, the Church hears from John 21, which, Scripture scholars tell us, is an addition to the Gospel's original text and inspired to counter early Christological heresies.

In this third appearance account, the apostles have returned to what they know best: fishing. The bursting netful of fish the disciples haul in at the direction of the "stranger" on shore is all the Beloved Disciple—representing every faithful disciple of the Lord—needs to recognize that Jesus is the stranger. His cry of "It is the Lord!" expresses his profound joy at seeing the resurrected Jesus again.

Cada año, el Evangelio del Tercer Domingo de Pascua presenta una aparición de Jesús a sus discípulos, después de su resurrección. Este año, la Iglesia escucha de Juan 21, que, según nos dicen los estudiosos de las Escrituras, es una adición al texto original del Evangelio e inspirado para contrarrestar las primeras herejías cristológicas.

En esta tercera aparición, los apóstoles han regresado a lo que mejor saben hacer: pescar. La red repleta de peces que los discípulos sacan en dirección al "extraño" en la orilla, es todo el Discípulo Amado— que representa a cada discípulo fiel del Señor— necesita reconocer que Jesús es el extraño. Su grito de "Es el Señor" expresa su profunda alegría al ver de nuevo a Jesús resucitado.

What is helpful for us in this vignette, however, is that the Beloved Disciple recognized Jesus in his works, i.e., in the great haul of fish. Recall that in the Gospel, Jesus constantly enjoined the Scribes and Pharisees to believe in him because of the works he did, but they refused to do so. We are challenged to recognize the risen Lord in the signs he continues to work in our midst today—the signs of the Word of God, the sacraments, and caring for our brothers and sisters.

BMA Update

We have a winner! From the sixty-seven donors who gifted or pledged \$350 or more to the Cathedral's 2022 BMA goal before February 28, Joseph and Linnea Williams were selected as the winners in the first raffle for the dinner with Bishop Myron Cotta. Thank you to Joe and Linnea and all who have donated thus far to the BMA this year—and to Bishop Cotta, the Bakers, and Yeagers for hosting this raffle prize.

Two more raffles remain: When the Cathedral reaches its participation goal of 300 families (currently we have 206 donors), they will be entered in a raffle for a private tasting at Noble Flower Farms—to include wines from local wineries and hors d'oeuvres for up to six adults.

Finally, when the parish reaches its BMA goal of \$102,989, all donors will be entered in a raffle for a guided fishing trip on Lake Tahoe with Captain Mike Nielsen of Tahoe Topliners. This expedition includes fishing on Lake Tahoe for two with fishing poles and tackle included. As of April 27, the Cathedral was credited with donations totaling \$75,494. Thank you!

The U.S. bishops have long said that Scouting is youth ministry, building character and citizenship while providing opportunities for achievement and outdoor adventure.

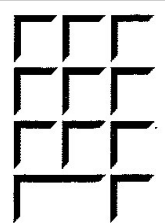
