achievers, community leaders, and contributors to the American economy. Nevertheless, they lack access to permanent legal status and citizenship and face continued uncertainty about their future in the United States. This uncertainty has been exacerbated by years of legal challenges.

The Catholic bishops of the United States have long called on Congress to provide Dreamers with the ability to integrate as fully recognized members of our society. Bishop Mario Dorsonville, chairman of the USCCB’s Committee on Migration, has encouraged members of Congress to make the tenth anniversary of DACA “the long-awaited inflection point that leads to a permanent solution for all Dreamers—one of many steps to address an immigration system in desperate need of reform.”

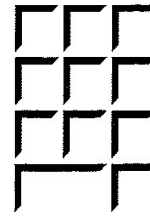
