This summer, I have had the opportunity to spend time out on the water—not necessarily swimming, but on my stand-up paddleboard (SUP, for short). It is one of my favorite things to do during the warmer months because it allows me to enjoy God’s beautiful creation while soaking in the sun, relaxing on the water, and breathing in the fresh air.



Perhaps it is the sun, water, and air that we take for granted most in our lives. These are some of the most necessary elements of life: we need the sun for light and energy, we need water to hydrate, and we need air to breathe! Understandably, this happens to all of us. But this realization points to something important: perhaps we forget to be grateful for the simplest—and most necessary—things in life because we can get caught up in the “busyness” of life. Even more so, maybe the issue is not having a “busy” schedule; perhaps the issue is our perspective.

We tend to use the word “busy” to describe our lives. It is how we often answer the question, “How are you?” While understandable, perhaps “busy” is not the best word to describe the life we are called to live. In fact, “busyness” has a rather negative connotation. Instead, we can use the word “full” to describe our lives. We want our lives to be “full of life,” right?

This is the key. As Christians, we want to describe our lives not simply by the standards of society, but by our attentiveness to the presence of God in our everyday lives. Brother Lawrence, in *The Practice of the Presence of God*, and Jacques Philippe, in *Time for God*, both encourage us to recognize and respond to God’s presence in the ordinary moments of our lives. This is especially important during the month of September, as we approach calendars “full” of work and school functions, family life, and the beginning of the holiday season. Our schedules may become full, but the question is: What is filling our lives?

As we enter PSL season (Pumpkin Spice Latte season), flannel season, and party season, it will be easy to get caught up in the “busyness” of life. So I invite you to take a moment throughout the day to look up at the sun and thank God for its light, to wash your hands and thank God for the gift of water, or to take a deep breath and thank God for the gift of air.

Gratitude is a beautiful form of prayer, and these small moments can help us practice the presence of God in our daily lives. Whether you are sitting in the car, working at your desk, walking through the grocery store, or out on the lake with your SUP, take the time to be thankful for the many gifts that the good and gracious Lord has bestowed upon you.

Perhaps then, instead of simply having a “busy” life, we can begin to see our lives for what they truly are: full of life, full of gratitude, and—most importantly—full of God.

Este verano, he tenido la oportunidad de pasar tiempo en el agua—no necesariamente nadando, sino sobre mi tabla de paddle surf (SUP, por sus siglas en inglés). Es una de mis actividades favoritas durante los meses más cálidos, porque me permite disfrutar de la hermosa creación de Dios mientras disfruto del sol, me relajo sobre el agua y respiro el aire fresco.

Quizás sean el sol, el agua y el aire algunas de las cosas que más damos por sentadas en nuestra vida. Estos son algunos de los elementos más necesarios para la vida: necesitamos el sol para tener luz y energía, necesitamos el agua para hidratarnos y necesitamos el aire para respirar. ¡Es comprensible que esto nos pase a todos! Pero esta realidad nos señala algo importante: quizás nos olvidamos de agradecer las cosas más sencillas—y más necesarias—de la vida porque podemos dejarnos atrapar por el “ajetreo” de la vida. Más aún, tal vez el problema no sea tener un horario “ocupado”; quizás el problema esté en nuestra manera de ver las cosas.

Tendemos a usar la palabra “ocupado” para describir nuestra vida. Es así como muchas veces respondemos a la pregunta: “¿Cómo estás?”. Aunque es comprensible, quizás “ocupado” no sea la mejor palabra para describir la vida a la que estamos llamados. De hecho, la palabra “ajetreo” tiene una connotación bastante negativa. En cambio, podemos usar la palabra “llena” para describir nuestra vida. Queremos que nuestra vida esté “llena de vida”, ¿verdad?

Esta es la clave. Como cristianos, no queremos describir nuestra vida simplemente según los criterios de la sociedad, sino según nuestra atención a la presencia de Dios en nuestra vida cotidiana. El Hermano Lorenzo, en *La práctica de la presencia de Dios*, y Jacques Philippe, en *Tiempo para Dios*, nos animan a reconocer y responder a la presencia de Dios en los momentos ordinarios de nuestra vida. Esto es especialmente importante durante el mes de septiembre, cuando nos acercamos a calendarios “llenos” de actividades laborales y escolares, de vida familiar y del comienzo de la temporada de fiestas. Nuestros horarios pueden llenarse, pero la pregunta es: ¿Qué está llenando nuestra vida?

Al entrar en la temporada del PSL (Pumpkin Spice Latte), la temporada de las camisas de franela y la temporada de fiestas, será fácil dejarnos atrapar por el “ajetreo” de la vida. Por eso, los invito a tomarse un momento durante el día para mirar hacia el sol y darle gracias a Dios por su luz, para lavarse las manos y darle gracias a Dios por el don del agua, o para respirar profundamente y darle gracias a Dios por el don del aire.

La gratitud es una hermosa forma de oración, y estos pequeños momentos pueden ayudarnos a practicar la presencia de Dios en nuestra vida diaria. Ya sea que estén sentados en el automóvil, trabajando en su escritorio, caminando por el supermercado o disfrutando del lago sobre su tabla de SUP, tómense el tiempo para agradecer los muchos dones que el Señor, bueno y misericordioso, les ha concedido.

Quizás entonces, en lugar de simplemente tener una vida “ocupada”, podamos comenzar a ver nuestra vida por lo que verdaderamente es: llena de vida, llena de gratitud y—lo más importante—llena de Dios.
