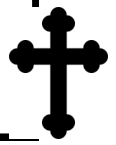

Coats/Gloves/Hats

The temperature outside has been dropping. We take the children outside several times a day, including in the morning when it is frequently around 30 degrees Fahrenheit. Licensing requires that we provide a certain percentage of our day outside.
