## Valentine's Day Parties

Each class will be celebrating a Valentine's Day Party. They will be held on Wed, February 12th (MWF) and Thu, February 13th (TTH). A party sign-up is available on the front counter. We ask that each family volunteer to bring one item per child to contribute to our snack. Please remember to sign up for both classes if your child is enrolled five days a week. In addition, we ask that the children bring valentine cards for each of their classmates, approximately 40 cards. The cards do not need to be addressed to their friends but should have their own name on them. We have changed our request for valentine cards due to the large number of children who attend preschool five days a week. For our students who attend every day, you will only have to bring cards for one preschool class. If your child's last name begins with A through L, bring 40 valentine cards on Wednesday, February 12th; if your child's last name begins with M through Z, bring 40 valentine cards on Thursday, February 13th. Pre-K students will be asked to bring additional valentine's for their Pre-K Valentine Party. Additional information will go home in their folder.
