Reminder

When your child mutters those five words in the morning before school, please don't pass-it off as an attempt to stay home from school. Flu season is here! If your child has a fever, sore throat, diarrhea, vomiting, body aches and/or congested cough, he or she must not come to school. This is for the safety of all the children as well as the teachers. **Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.** Remember, your child must be free from fever, diarrhea and related symptoms for at least 24 hours before they will be allowed to return to school. We will send home any child who doesn't feel well whether he or she has fever or not. Thank you again for your efforts in assisting us.
