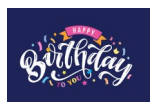
Classroom Happenings

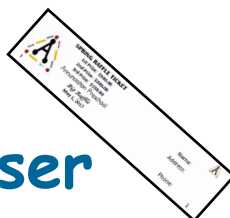

Coats/Gloves/Hats

The temperature outside has been dropping. We take the children outside several times a day, including in the morning when it is frequently around 30 degrees Fahrenheit. Licensing requires that we provide a certain percentage of our day outside. In order for us to comply with licensing, we are asking you to send your child to school in clothing that is appropriate to play outside in cold conditions. Warm coats, hats, and gloves or mittens are needed to keep them warm in the inclement weather. Many children have the same or similar items. Please label them with your child's name.
