## lealth Clinic

#### Masks

Thank you again for your incredible patience as we constantly evaluate new mandates and requirements. The mask regulations for childcare centers continue to evolve daily. After fully discerning the bishop's letter, we will be making some adjustments in our classroom. The bishop states, "It is after much reflection and consideration of reports from our public health officials. I have decided that in order for us to move forward as the Diocese of Stockton, masks for students will be strongly recommended in our Catholic schools, effective March 1, 2022. The use of other mitigation strategies will continue to be used to support a healthy working and learning environment. For those who wish for their child to continue to wear a mask, we will fully support this choice." The staff of Annunciation Preschool will continue to wear their mask to keep your child and fellow employees healthy. Although we

are not requiring that the children wear their mask, it will still be highly recommended. If you choose to have your child attend school without a mask, your child will be at a higher risk of contacting a communicable disease, including COVID. Thank you for your continued support!

#### Reminder

When your child mutters those five words in the morning before school, please don't pass-it off as an attempt to stay home from school. Flu season is here! If your child has a fever, sore throat, diarrhea, vomiting, body aches and/or congested cough, he or she must not come to school. This is for the safety of all the children as well as the teachers. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. Remember, your child must be free from fever, diarrhea and related symptoms for at least 24 hours before they will be allowed to return to school We will send home any child who doesn't feel well whether he or she has fever or not. Thank you again for your efforts in assisting us.
