### Communication

### Curriculum

We will introduce the letters Y through Z along with the sounds and Zoophonic movements associated with each of these letters. We will also review letters V through W the first week of May. The children will explore units on Mother's Day, Gardening, Farm and Zoo. We are spending a few weeks on the concept of primary colors and so we will reinforce the Rr sound and the color Red by celebrating Red Day on Friday, May 7th; the Yy sound and the color Yellow by celebrating Yellow day on Friday, May 14th; and the Bb sound and the color Blue by celebrating Blue day on Friday, May 21st. Remember to have your child wear these colors on the corresponding color day.
